### Lesson 1 THE BEGINNING OF CREATION



Reference: Genesis 1:1-25

Aim: To make the children aware that everything around us has been created by God.

Memory Verse: Genesis 1:1 – In the beginning God created the Heavens and the Earth.

Introduction: Hi friends, have you ever gone to a zoo? Have you seen the animals like Deer, Lion, Bear, Tiger, Hare, etc.? Did you like them? How many of you like flowers? Which are the flowers you like the most? There are many flowers like the Rose, Sunflower, Lotus, Jasmine, China Rose, etc. Besides these, there are mountains, hills, sea, rivers; all these have been created by God. We are going to learn today the facts of creation.

Detailed Lesson: The earth created in the beginning did not have the form and beauty like we see today. The earth was covered with water and darkness. The earth that is seen today with its

beauty was created in six days. Let us see what God did on the first day.

One day God decided to beautify the earth. God said "Let there be Immediately there was light. The light was called as day and the darkness was called as night. God was very happy to see this. Thus the first day was over.

Then God created sky (heaven). Thus the sky as we see today was made. This was the second day.

The third day God made the dry land. God commanded the waters to gather at one place. And it was so. The dry land was called earth. The waters were called Seas. This also made God happy. God again said "Let the earth bring grass and fruit bearing trees". And it was so. The fruits like apples, oranges, mangoes, grapes, etc. loved by all your friends were made.

You may be interested to know what happened on the fourth day. Isn't it? God commanded "Let there be lights in the sky to divide day and night". This lighted the earth. God said "Let them be for days, years and seasons". And it was so.

On the fifth day God created the fishes and birds which are liked by our friends the most. Big whales and tiny fishes were made in the sea. The chirping birds started flying in the sky. Birds like doves, parrots, crane, kite, etc. were created. God saw that it was good.

Thus the seas, dry land, sky, lights, fishes, birds, etc. were created. Friends, can you tell now who all were left to be made? (Let the children say). Alright! You know it was the animals and man. Isn't it? You have correctly answered it. On the sixth day, God created animals and on the last God created man. God created the cattle, crawling animals, wild animals in the forest, etc. God saw it was good. Thus the plants, trees, birds, fishes, etc. began their life on the earth.

Dear friends, did you like the story of creation? Next week we will see how God created human being.

**Summary:** Without God, nothing was created. Everything has been created and is controlled by God alone.























#### Lesson 2

# THE FIRST PARENTS AND THEIR DISOBEDIENCE



Reference: Genesis 1:26-31; 2:7-8, 18-25; 3:1-24

Aim: To make the children aware of the facts that Adam and Eve whom were created to live with God, lost their place due to their disobedience and those who obey God, can live with Him.

Memory Verse: The wages of sin is death (Romans 6:23).

Introduction: Is there anyone here who has not been beaten with stick by your parents? Why you were beaten? (Allow the children to answer). Oh, you were beaten when you were disobedient. Isn't it? Today we are going to learn about how God created our First Parents and thereafter how He punished them when they were disobedient.

**Detailed Lesson:** On the sixth day of creation after God made the living animals, He decided to create man in His own image. Friends, you might have made images of something with mud and clay? Like that God made an image out of dust and water. Then He breathed into his nostrils. As soon as God breathed, the lifeless image became living.





The man opened his eyes and looked around. He saw God. The first man created by God was called Adam. God gave him authority over all the animals, birds and the fishes of sea and on the entire earth. All living things were under the control of man. Adam was God's son (Luke 3:38).

God made Adam to live in a beautiful garden. The name of the garden was Eden. All kinds of trees were there. Adam did not have a companion yet. God decided to make a companion for Adam. God brought all living creatures to Adam. Adam named all of them and that was it name. But for Adam no suitable companion was found.

God gave Adam a deep sleep. Then God took out one of his ribs and made a woman out of it. She stood before Adam. Adam liked this beautiful friend. He called her Eve.

God told some important things to Adam who was in the garden of Eden. All the fruits of the garden they could eat. But from the tree at the centre that bears the fruit which gives the knowledge about the good and bad should not be eaten. Sometimes your Papa or Mummy forbids you from doing a thing. Do you obey it? Good. Good children, are like that.

One day Eve was walking around the garden. She reached the centre of the garden. When she was watching the beautiful fruit of a tree, Satan came to her in the form of a serpent. The serpent asked Eve "Has God commanded you not to eat any fruit of the garden"? Eve replied "God commanded us to eat all fruits of the trees in the garden. But you should not eat the fruit of the tree at the centre so that you will die".

The tricky snake tricked Eve into eating the fruit. It said "You will surely not die. You will become like God if you eat the fruit". Eve trusted on the serpent's words more than God's word. She ate the fruit and gave it to Adam. Both of them ate the forbidden fruit.

The first parents who sinned lost the sonship, which they had from God. They had had the glory of God around them, so they did not need clothes to cover them. They did not feel ashamed. But when Eve disobeyed God and when they ate the fruit which He said not to, they suddenly felt ashamed and made clothes for themselves out of tree leaves and started wearing them.

**Summary:** Through disobedience the man lost the love and fortune of the Eden Garden. But if those who obey God, He return them the privileges and sonship

#### Lesson 4

## NOAH, WHO OBEYED GOD



Reference: Genesis 6:13-22; 7:1-12, 19, 24; 8:1-22

Aim: To convince the children that obedience is the first step towards blessings.

Memory Verse: Acts 5:29 – We ought to obey God rather than men.

Introduction: Have you seen any ship like the one in this picture? (Show

the picture of ship in this lesson and ask the children. Let the children answer). Ships travel only in water. There are many types of ships.

Long, long ago God told a man called Noah to build such a ship (ark). Today we are going to learn about Noah who made a ship (ark) according to God's instructions.

**Detailed Lesson:** During the time of Noah, people did wrong things. Telling lies, stealing, quarrelling, killing, etc. were the wrongs done by people. Doing these wrongs disliked by God is called sin. Therefore God decided to destroy all the wicked people and all living things.

God desired to rescue Noah who was a righteous man in the midst of the generation of disobedient people. Noah had a wife and three sons namely Shem, Ham and Japheth. God appeared to Noah and

Therefore, you and your



family should make an Ark and enter into it. I will send a flood and destroy everything. If you enter into the ark, you and your family will be saved.

Friends, have you seen rain? (Let the children answer) Oh, so you

have had a bath in the rain. Isn't it? Till the time of Noah there was no rainfall or flood on the earth. When the earth is completely filled and covered with rain water, it is called flood. When God told Noah that there will be flood, he believed it. Noah started to make an ark (ship) of three storeys with Gopher wood as said by God. Friends! Do you know what Gopher wood is? Gopher is a tree like mango tree or teak wood that is around us. God also told Noah the measurement of the ark. Noah made the ark with windows and doors as per the measurement and wood as told by God. To prevent water coming in, he applied slime inside and outside the ark. Slime is a special glue.

As told by God, Noah, his wife, 3 sons and their wives, a total of 8 people entered the ark. Besides them, a pair of each animal and other living creature comprising one male and female also entered the ark. Noah stored necessary food for all these also in the ark.

God closed the door of the ark. Thereafter it rained for 40 days continuously. Have you seen flood? When a river overflows and water level increases on land, destruction takes place. A great flood occurred due to the heavy rain for 40 days. Water level increased and reached till the top of the tallest mountain. All the men were destroyed in the flood. However the righteous Noah and his family were saved as they obeyed God.

Friends, we should obey God like Noah did. Due to their obedience Noah and his family were saved. God punished those who did not obey. Those who hear the words of God will be saved from all dangers.

Gist: We must obey God even if our friends do not obey.

# Lesson 6 ABRAHAM WHO TRUSTED IN GOD




**Reference**: Genesis 11:31-12:9; Acts 7:2-4; Galatians 3:6-9; Hebrews 11:8

After the death of his father, Abraham again started the journey. He was 75 years old at that time.

After many days of journey they reached a place called Canaan. That place was so beautiful. They saw many marvellous scenes like flowers, fruits, rivers, mountains, grasslands, etc. and the like that gives pleasure to the eyes. On that day God again appeared to Abraham. He said "this is the land I have promised to you". Thus Abraham started worshipping God there.







### Lesson 7

Reference: Genesis 15:1-5; 17:15-19; 18:1-15; 21:1-3

Aim: To make the children aware that God never changes from his promises.

**Memory Verse**: Malachi 3:6 – I the Lord who does not change

Introduction: Friends, are there little babies in your house? Some of you might have younger brothers or sisters. Isn't it? Those who do not have younger ones might have sometime thought of having

one. Isn't it? This is because we like the smiles and playfulness of toddlers. Today we are going to learn about the birth of a small baby

in a house and the happiness related to it.

Detailed Lesson: When Abraham was living in Canaan, God appeared to him. Then He said to Abraham, "Fear not, I will reward you for your obedience. I will protect you".

Abraham and his wife Sarah did not have child. They had been praying for many years to God for a child. They were sad as they did not have a child.



Abraham asked God "What will you give me? I do not have a son. My wealth will be inherited by my servants". God replied to Abraham "your wealth will not be inherited by you servants. Your own child will inherit it".

After saying this God brought Abraham out of his house. Friends, what can you see when we look at the sky on a dark night? (Let the children

answer). Right, the shining stars can be seen. God said to Abraham "You look at the sky. Count the stars if you can". Friends can you count the stars? Abraham understood that stars cannot be counted. Then God said to Abraham "I will give you children like them".

Some days passed. God again appeared to Abraham. On these days, Abraham and his wife Sarah have been praying to God for a child as promised by God. One day Abraham was sitting in the garden of Mamre. Abraham saw three people coming to his house and he welcomed them. He made them sit under the shadow of a tree. He gave them food to eat. They were God's Angels. After having food satisfactorily, they said to Abraham "Next year at this time a son will be born to you". However Abraham and Sarah could not believe it as they were very old.

Thus, God blessed Sarah according to His promise. Sarah gave birth to a baby at the time as told by God. The baby born to Abraham through Sarah was named as Isaac. Abraham was 100 years and Sarah 90 years old when the cute baby was born to them. There was great cheer in that family where there was no baby.

# Lesson 8 THE OBEDIENT ISAAC



Reference: Genesis 22:1-9

Aim: To make the children aware that if we obey God and our

parents, we will receive blessings.

Memory Verse: Ephesians 6:1 - Children, obey your parents in the Lord.

Introduction: Friends, whom do you love the most? Oh, right, right, you love Papa and Mamma the most. Similarly, your Papa and Mummy love you the most. Friends, do you know what is the reason for it? It is because you are their children and you obey them. Similarly, today we are going to study about our forefather Abraham who lived long time ago and who obeyed God and also about his son Isaac who also obeyed his father.

Detailed Lesson: Abraham and his wife Sarah were happily living with their son Isaac when God decided to test Abraham. God called Abraham by name and spoke to him. Like friends talk to each God other. and Abraham used to talk to each other. God said to Abraham "take your only begotten son, the son you love the most to a mountain to be shown by me in the land of Moriah and offer him as sacrifice". One good day, God desired this from



Abraham. In those days the practice was to offer animals as sacrifice. Abraham must have become sad when he heard about this requirement of God. Anyhow Abraham decided to obey God.

The next day, Abraham rose up very early and prepared for the journey. He started towards the place told by God along with Isaac, two servants,

a donkey for carrying the wood and other material required for sacrifice. The distance to that place was a three days journey. When they reached near the place, Abraham asked his servants to stay back there. Then Abraham carried the fire and knife and walked to the mountain with Isaac who carried the wood required for the sacrifice. At this time Isaac did not know that the offering of sacrifice was he himself. When they were climbing the mountain, Isaac asked his father "Father, we have fire and wood but where is the lamb for sacrifice"? Though Abraham was sad about the question yet he replied 'God will take care". Thus they reached the top of the mountain.

Abraham made an altar with the stones available there. He then bound Isaac's hands and legs and laid him on it. All the while Isaac obeyed his father like a lamb. He did not show any disobedience. Abraham took the knife to kill Isaac. Suddenly there was call from the heaven "Abraham, Abraham, don't lay your hands on Isaac. As you have not hesitated to offer your only begotten son, I know that you obey and regard God". Abraham was very happy. He removed all the bindings on Isaac. Isaac came out of the altar. When Abraham looked around, he saw a lamb in the wilderness. Abraham offered that lamb as sacrifice and returned to their home happily.


**Summary:** It is God's commandment that we must obey our parents. Therefore, we all should be obedient to our parents.

Jacob loved Joseph the most. This was because he had good characters and was obedient. Besides this, Joseph used to inform his father about the bad habits and quarrel between his elder brothers. Therefore his father got a good multi coloured garment for him. This caused his brothers to be jealous of him. Jealousy is not liked by God. Whatever is not liked by God is a sin.

Joseph dreamt a dream when he was 17 years old. He told the same to his brothers. His brothers got angry towards him. Joseph started explaining about his dream. "We all were harvesting wheat in the field. When we made sheaves, my sheaf arose. Your sheaves stood roundabout and made obeisance to my sheaf". When his brothers heard the dream they asked him whether he will become their king. His brothers hated him more.

After some days, Joseph had another dream. "I have dreamt another dream. The sun, the moon and eleven stars made obeisance to me", Joseph told this dream to his father and brothers. 





# Lesson 11 THE GOD WHO GUARDED JOSEPH




Reference: Genesis 37:12-36

**Memory Verse**: Genesis 39:21 – The Lord was with him.

Introduction: Have you ever been sent by your Papa or Mummy to call your brother or sister who has gone to play in the neighbourhood? Yes. Isn't it? Like this, a father sent his son to enquire about his brothers.





Accordingly Joseph went from Hebron valley to Shechem along with necessary food for them. He wore the special garment given by his father for the journey.

After two to three days of journey, Joseph reached Shechem. He searched for his brothers everywhere but could not find them. At the end he came to know from travellers that they were in Dothan. Thus Joseph went to Dothan in search of his brothers. His brothers recognized him from far off. That was because he wore the special garment given by his father.

The brothers who were waiting for an occasion to torment Joseph took it as an opportunity. They planned to kill Joseph. His eldest brother Reuben, however, prevented them from killing Joseph. Instead they decided to put him in a dry well.

When Joseph reached his brothers, they snatched and took the food sent for them. They stripped him of the special garment given to him out of love by his father. Then they put in him in a dry well. A dry well is a useless well without water.

After putting Joseph in the dry well they sat down to eat, when they found a group of traders going to Egypt. Then one of Joseph's brothers, Judah told the other brothers "Let us do one thing. We will sell him to these traders. We will get money". Thus they took Joseph out from the dry well. They sold him as a slave for twenty silver coins. In ancient time, men were used to be sold as slaves like we sell cow or goat today. Such sale of men is called slave trading. These traders took Joseph to Egypt. Thus Joseph was rescued by God from his brothers who had decided to kill him.

The brothers tore his garment and soaked it the blood of a lamb and took it to Jacob. Jacob recognised the garment as of Joseph. He thought that some cruel animal might have killed Joseph. Jacob grieved for Joseph for a long time.

**Summary:** God rescues those who love Him from all adversaries and protects them.





# JOSEPH - FROM THE DRY WELL TO THE POSITION OF PRIME MINISTER



Reference: Genesis chapters 39-41

Aim: To make the children understand that God protects and exalts

those who are obedient to Him.

Memory Verse: Genesis 39:21 - The Lord was with him

Introduction: Friends, do you know who is our Chief Minister?
O.K., who is the Prime Minister of India? The chief governing officer of a country is called Prime Minister. Today we are going to study the events in the life of a man called Joseph who became the Prime Minister of Egypt.

**Detailed Lesson:** You might be remembering the event about Joseph who was put in the dry well and thereafter sold to the Egyptian traders.

A man called Potiphar bought Joseph from the traders for a price. This man was the

Captain of the guards. In the ancient time, men were sold and bought as slaves. As soon as Joseph came to Potiphar's house as a slave, it began to prosper. When Potiphar grasped that he was being blessed due to Joseph, he entrusted the

entire house to Joseph.

After a few days, Joseph was punished for a crime that was not done by him. Poor fellow Joseph! In spite of not doing any crime he was put into prison. Still God was with him there too.



One day, the king of Egypt saw a dream. None of the wise men of the country could explain the meaning of that dream. The king was in trouble. At that time somebody told the King about Joseph. The king understood Joseph's ability to interpret the meaning of dreams and so asked him to be brought to the palace.

Joseph who was in the prison was in a bad shape with both his hair and beard grown long. He was shaved, bathed and made to wear good clothes and brought in to King's presence by the servants of the king. The king told Joseph both the dreams dreamt by him. In the dream, the king was standing on the river bank and seven fat fleshed cows came out of the river. Immediately, seven lean fleshed cows also came behind them. But the lean fleshed cows swallowed the fat fleshed cows. This was the first dream.

In the second dream, the king saw a field seven ears of good corns came upon one stalk. After that seven defavoured corns also came up. The defavoured corns swallowed the good corns.

When Joseph prayed, God revealed the meanings of these dreams to him. Joseph explained it detail to the King. There will be seven prosperous years. Thereafter there will be seven years of famine. This was the meaning of the dream. Joseph also suggested to the king to collect food in the first seven prosperous years so that it can be used in the latter seven years of famine. The king liked Joseph because he interpreted the dreams. He was appointed as the Prime Minister of the country. Thus, Joseph who was in jail was exalted to the position of Prime Minister.

Under the leadership of Joseph, the grains were collected and stored in the granaries (godown) of the cities during the first seven prosperous years. The same was distributed to people in the years of famine. Thus due to the advice of Joseph, the country was saved from famine.

**Summary:** Those who love God will be given wisdom and knowledge. God will exalt and bless them more than others.

# Lesson 13 MOSES - THE CHILD GUARDED BY GOD



Reference: Exodus 2:1-10

**Aim**: To make the children understand that God provides relief to the suffering people.

**Memory Verse**: Psalms 41:2 – The Lord will preserve him, and keep him alive. **Introduction**: Do you have younger brothers or sisters at home? It is very jovial to have toddlers in the house. We can play with them. Their smiles make us cheerful. But we cannot bear to see our children being tormented. Today we are going to learn about a child who was tormented.

**Detailed Lesson:** Jacob and family members came to know that Joseph is in Egypt as Prime Minister. They came to Egypt and started living in a place called Goshen. Jacob was given a new name by God as Israel. Thereafter Jacob's sons were called Israel. The further generations that followed Jacob's twelve sons were called Hebrews.

After some years, the people of Israel increased. After the death of Joseph and his brothers, a king ruled over Egypt who did not know Joseph. He hated the Israelites.

He started troubling the Israelites. They were made heavy jobs. Their population kept on increasing as their torment increased. The king called the nurses and said "Kill if a male child is born to Israelites. But if it is girl child, let it live". But those nurses feared God more than the king, they did not do it.

Thus, when the population of Israel could not be controlled, the king announced a new decree. All the male children of the Israelites. That should be thrown in to Nile River



immediately after birth, was the new ordinance.

Poor children! All the male children were snatched from their parents and thrown into the Nile and killed. A great wailing arose among the Israelites. They started crying to God.

One day a cute male child was born to one Amram and Jochebed. As the child was very pretty, they hid him for 3 months. This child had a sister named Miriam and an elder brother named Aaron. They took care of him for 3 months hiding him from the king's soldiers. When the child's noise became louder than they could handle, they took a sad decision. That was to place the child in a box and put in the Nile River. They made a basket made from bulrush/ Papyrus plant (is a type of reed (like grass) that grows in marshy places near river banks). They put slime inside and outside of the basket so that no water enters in to the basket. Then, prepared a small bedding, laid the child and closed the basket. The box was kept among the plants that were growing in the river water close to the bank.

His sister Miriam waited at a distance to see what would happen to the child. At that time the princess came to the River for a bath. She saw the basket lying in the middle of grass. She told her servants to bring the basket. Lo! When the basket was opened a cute child was crying. The princess liked the child. She decided to take care of him. Miriam who was waiting and watching came near to the princess. As desired by the daughter of Pharaoh, the mother of the child was called to take care of him.

The princess said "Take of this baby and nurse him for me". The princess gave her wages for taking care of the child. Thus the mother of the child itself fed the child.

As the child was taken out from water, he was named as Moses. Thus God saved the child Moses from death. This child Moses grew and redeemed the Israelites from slavery in Egypt.

Summary: God loves all of us. He will save us from enemies.

are going to learn this.


The child **Detailed Lesson:** Samuel, about whom we studied in the previous lesson grew and became a great prophet of Israel. A Prophet is the person who hears from God and conveys the same to men. Till that time Israel did not have a king. They demanded from Samuel to give them a king.

God gave them Saul as king. Saul is the first king of Israel.

After some years, Saul

King

started





disobeying God. Friends, God does not like disobedience. It is a sin. As Saul was disobedient, God removed him from kingship. The Prophet Samuel was very sad about Saul. Thereafter God said to Samuel that in place of Saul, He had chosen David, the son of Jesse as king. Therefore you have rush to the house of Jesse in Bethlehem

and anoint the person He is going to show as king.

David was the youngest of 8 children of Jesse who lived in the town of Bethlehem. His occupation feeding the flock. David loved God very much.

Thus Samuel went to Bethlehem. The people were frightened when prophet of God came to their town. They enquired as to whether his visit is for peace. "I have come in peace", Samuel said. Samuel arranged for worship there. He invited Jesse and his sons.

Thus everyone came to worship along with Samuel. Jesse and his sons reached for the worship. When Samuel saw Eliab, the eldest son of Jesse, he thought that he might have been chosen as the king. None of them were chosen by God as King.






obedience to God, that took place long time ago.

**Detailed Lesson:** Long time ago a king named Nebuchadnezzar reigned over Babylon. He once went to war against Jerusalem. He brought Israelites from Jerusalem as captives. Among them there were youths also. They were Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego.

One day Nebuchadnezzar made a huge golden statue. He set it on a vast ground. Then he sent out a decree. All the people including the ministers, prince, governors and officers must bow down before the statue.

"When you hear all kinds of music, you must fall and worship the golden image I have set. Anyone who does not fall down and worship shall be cast in to the midst of a burning fiery furnace". This was the decree.

All people knelt down before the statue and worshipped it as per the decree of the King. However the three Jewish youth i.e. Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego did not bow down before the statue. This was because they were





Jewish youth who worshipped only Jehovah God. They obeyed the commands of God more than the decree of king.

Some people who were waiting for an opportunity to find fault with the Jews, informed about this to the king. The king became angry. He ordered to call for the three youth. When the young men came before the king, he ordered them again to worship the statue. "If you bow

down before the statue now, I will set you free. Otherwise I will put you into the fire", the king said. Yet, they did not obey the decree of the king.

The king became more furious. He called few of his healthy soldiers and asked them to put these children into the fiery furnace. Besides this, he also ordered to increase the fire seven times fold. They put more logs and tar to increase the heat.

As per the order of king, the soldiers bound Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego and cast them into the fire. The soldiers who put the youth into the fire were burnt to death due to the heat of the fire.

King Nebuchadnezzar who wanted to see the Jewish youth dying in the fire was astonished to see the actual scene in the fire. He rose up in a hurry and asked his officers "Did not we put three men bound into the furnace"? "True, O King", they answered. But there are four unbound persons walking in the fire. They are unhurt. Moreover, the fourth person looks like a Son of God.

The king came near the fire and asked Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego to come out of the fire. The Ministers and other officers also gathered to see them. The king understood that the God of Israel had come down and saved them. Therefore the king made a new decree. The God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego is the true God. Therefore any one working against this God shall be punished, was the new decree. Thus, God saved the three Jewish youth from the fire.

**Summary:** We the worshippers of the true God must not worship any other gods. Whatever be the adversity, we must stand for the true God like Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego did. Then God will deliver us.








# Lesson 17 JONAH WHO DISOBEYED

LET US HEAR

Reference

Jonah Chapters 1-4.

Aim

To teach the kids that we must obey what God says to

us and that if we disobey, He will punish us.

**Memory Verse:** 


1Samuel 15:22 – To obey is better than sacrifice.

Introduction: Are you good children who obey your parents? Sometimes you are disobedient. Isn't it? Then, your parents give you little punishments. Similarly, today we are going to learn about a prophet who displeased God and he was punished by God.

**Detailed Lesson:** Jonah was God's prophet. Prophet is a person who conveys God's message to the people. Once God said to Jonah, "Go and preach in the city of Nineveh". Nineveh was a big city in those days. The people there did a lot of wrong things and lived without obeying God. Therefore God decided to destroy the city. God told Jonah to go there and convey this message to the people.

Nineveh was a city in a country which was Israel's enemy. Therefore Jonah had no interest to go there. One had to travel in a ship to go to Nineveh. Instead of boarding a ship for Nineveh, Jonah boarded the one going to Tarshish in the opposite direction from that of Nineveh. Then he went to the base of the ship and started sleeping calmly.

God decided to teach him a \ lesson for disobeying Him. He caused a strong wind to blow against the ship. The wind blew very strongly. The waves rose very high. The ship tossed in the waves. Friends, you might





have heard about the destruction of big houses by strong winds. Similarly the wind blew against the ship. The travellers were frightened and started crying. They called upon their gods and started running here and there inside the ship. They threw out the heavy things to make the ship lighter and stop water coming in.

The Captain of the ship saw that Jonah was sleeping while all these crying and commotion was going on. A Captain is the person who controls the ship. The captain asked Jonah "Why are you sleeping? Rise and pray to your god. Perhaps it may save us". Again the wind became stronger. They felt that someone in the ship had sinned and, therefore, they were in this danger. They started finding out that person. They wrote each one's name and cast a lot. The lot fell on Jonah. They questioned Jonah. Jonah agreed that he was travelling against the will of God.

Jonah told them that if he was thrown into the sea, everything would alright and they would saved. They threw Jonah into the sea half heartedly. Poor fellow Jonah! He fell into the sea. But God had commanded a big fish to swallow Jonah. Thus Jonah was now in the belly of the fish. The fish swam in the sea with Jonah for 3 days.

Sitting in the stomach of the fish, Jonah confessed to God about his mistake and prayed. God heard his prayers. According to God's command the fish vomited Jonah onto the shore. Then Jonah went to Nineveh. By his preaching, all the people living in that city repented and prayed to God. God removed the punishment that was decided earlier.

**Summary:** God punished Jonah who travelled against His will. Similarly if we do not obey God, he will punish us.





Introduction: The birth of a child in a house is a day of happiness. It is common


in our place to distribute sweets on that occasion. The relatives and friends of that family will give small clothes, etc. to the child as gift. Similarly, we are going to learn about the

Joseph's native place was Bethlehem.





our life.


Memory Verse: Psalms 139:14 - Your works are wonderful.

Friends, have you ever eaten grapes? You have. Isn't it? We all like sweet grapes. Friends, you also like the grape juice,





don't you? In Palestine, lots of grapes are grown. Therefore grape juice is taken along with food. Now, the serving of food was started. The guests were enjoying the tasty food. At that time the workers in the store came to know that wine was had finished. They were very sad as they did not know what to do. Mary, who also was a guest, came to know about

the matter regarding the finished wine. She informed the same to Jesus.

Mary who knew that Jesus is the Son of God told the servants "If He says something you should do accordingly". There were six vessels of stone kept for storing water needed for cleaning of the hands and feet according to the practice of Jews. When the appropriate time came, Jesus told the servants to fill these vessels with water. The servants filled it up to the brim. Jesus again said, "Now go and give this to the store keeper". The water had become good wine before the chief store keeper tasted it. In no time, the water turned into good wine. It was tastier than the wine served earlier. Other than the servants who filled the stone vessels, no one including the store keepers knew about the miracle done by Jesus.

It is a matter of shame today and even earlier if the food gets over at a wedding. Jesus saved this family from such a shameful situation. This was the first miracle done by Jesus. When Jesus' disciples saw, they believed him all the more.

**Summary:** We must understand that Jesus is God who does miracles. If we pray to Jesus in our needs, He will fulfill our empty situation.





Aim



of the little ship without sleeping. Friends, have you seen people paddling the oars of the boat or swift ships?

The journey was going on comfortably. Suddenly strong winds started to blow. Waves rose higher. The ship started getting tossed. Water started entering into the little ship. The disciples controlling it were in great trouble. The swift ship was surely going to sink. The disciples who had lots of experience in sailing in the sea tried to control as much they could do. At this time Jesus was sleeping in the boat on a pillow. The frightened disciples woke up Jesus immediately. "Master, we will sink and die. Don't you have any concern for us"? The disciples started crying. When Jesus woke up, He saw the frightened disciples and a disturbed sea.

Immediately Jesus rebuked the wind. He commanded the sea to be calm. The wind stopped instantly. The Sea was clam. The disciples were astonished to see both the wind and the sea calm at the word of Jesus. The wind and the sea too were obeying Jesus. They talked among themselves as to who Jesus is.

**Summary:** The God who created us has created the land and sea. Jesus being God, His commands are obeyed by all natural powers. Jesus can help us in all the adversities of our life. At times there can be problems in our life like it happened with the swift ships in which the disciples were travelling. However there is a solution for all such problems only if we tell it Jesus about it.







# Lesson 21 Five Thousand fed with Five Loaves



Reference

John 6:1-14

Aim

To submit ourselves for God's miraculous work.

**Memory Verse:** 

Psalms 136:25 – He gives food to all flesh; for His mercy

endures forever.

Introduction: Friends, when do you eat food? Morning, noon and evening. Isn't it? Then whenever we are hungry we have food at home. Have you ever fasted? Never, no? If we do not have food, we will feel hungry. Today we are going to learn about the event when Jesus fed the hungry people.

**Detailed Lesson:** One day Jesus and his disciples went to the other side of the Lake of Galilee.

A big crowd went with him to see the sick being healed and to get healed. Seeing the big

gathering, Jesus sat on top of a mountain along with the disciples. Jesus felt compassion towards the people who came travelling from distant places. He taught them and also healed the sick. Thus lot of time passed away. The crowd had been listening to Jesus' words without even

having food. But Jesus thought

about the hunger and thirst of the people.

He desired to give

them food.



Jesus asked the disciple, Philip "From where can we give food to this crowd"? Philip counted the money they had. He replied, "The money available with us will not suffice for feeding this crowd".

When they were talking, another disciple Andrew came to Jesus. He said "Here there is a boy with whom there are five loaves and two fishes".

Friends, when you go for long travel, your mother give you Tiffin. Isn't it? Like this, when this lad came to hear Jesus' preaching, his mother might have given this tiffin. But when Jesus asked for this tiffin, the lad gave it to Jesus with joy. Similarly friends, we must share our things with others.

Jesus told his disciples to make the people sit in the grassy valley. Friends, when you go for a marriage feast, you might have seen lots of people sitting in line and eating food. Like this, people sat in line. The men itself were about five thousand. Besides this, there were ladies and children. Jesus took the bread, praised the Lord for it and blessed it. He then gave the food to be served to the people sitting there. The loaves kept on increasing when they served it. Like this the fishes were also served till everyone was satisfied. Everyone ate and were filled. People were amazed over the miraculous work of Jesus.

They collected 12 baskets of loaves as left over. People believed in Jesus due to this miracle.

**Summary:** When the child's loaves and fishes were handed over to Jesus, it could be used to feed a hungry crowd and satisfy them. Like this, if we submit ourselves in the hands of God, he will use us for the blessing of others.

Jesus walked over the sea and reached them. When the disciples saw Jesus coming over the sea, they were frightened. They feared that it was a spirit.

understand that Jesus is the God who heals all diseases.


**Memory Verse:**

Introduction: Friends, have your ever gone to a hospital? People with different diseases are admitted and treated there. Isn't? Can you name few diseases? (Let the children answer). OK, correct, correct! Men have different types of diseases. For some diseases, no medicines have been found so far. Leprosy was one of the diseases that people feared earlier. Friends, have you heard of the disease Leprosy? The fingers and toes of leprosy patients get wasted. wounds and sores do not heal and therefore it has to be cut off. Today we are going to learn about an event in which Jesus healed a leprosy patient.

**Detailed Lesson:** When Jesus came down from the mountain after usual sermons, a big crowd followed Him. People used to follow Jesus to listen to His teachings, see the miracles and get healed. A leper who knew about Jesus' healings





came and fell on the feet of Jesus. Immediately the people gathered there moved away so as not to touch him. Friends, do you know why they did this? In those days, lepers had to live separately away from the society. The society considered leprosy as an ugly disease. The Jews normally made the lepers live outside their villages.

The leper who fell at the feet of Jesus had the desire and faith to get healed. Friends, Jesus does not send anyone away sad who comes to him. He will certainly help us if we have the desire and faith on Him. The leper said, "Jesus, you can heal me if you desire". Jesus felt compassion on him. Normally people take the other way if a leper is seen on the way. They never like to touch them. But the loving Jesus touched him. Friends, we should be able to call them lovingly and take care of those who are not loved or looked upon with hatred by the society like Jesus did. Friends, have you heard of Mother Teresa? She was a woman who used to take care, serve and help many such people who were seperated from the society. During our life, we should also have a mind to help others. Jesus said to the leper, "I have the desire. Be healed". Miraculous! Immediately, his leprosy disappeared. The leper was completely healed. The healed man thanked Jesus and went away.

**Summary:** By healing the leper, Jesus proved that He can heal any disease. Like Jesus, we should be compassionate to deal with people with any disease and be able to help them.














## Lesson 25 JESUS HEALS THE PARALYSED MAN



Reference

Mark 2:1-15

Aim

To create awareness among the children that Jesus heals all diseases; also that when we pray and work with faith for others, God accepts our prayer and gives deliverance.

**Memory Verse:** 

Exodus 15:26 – For I am the Lord who heals you.

**Introduction:** Have you seen people sitting on a wheel chair? They use such a chair as they have no strength in their legs and so cannot walk. You might have seen people lying on the bed with paralysis. If they have to be shifted to another place, they have to be carried with their bed itself. Today we are going to learn about such a paralysed man who was brought before Jesus by some people.


**Detailed Lesson:** One day, while Jesus was travelling and preaching in different places in Palestine, He reached in Peter's house in Capernaum. People came to know that Jesus was in Peter's house. A big crowd gathered to listen

to Him and get healed. The house was filled with people. People gathered in such a way that there was no place even at the door or in the veranda. The crowd had gathered

there as they knew that ( Jesus was inside.

People loved to go to the place where

Jesus was as





He gave them physical healing and mental happiness. Jesus started to preach to the crowd. If Jesus lives in the hearts of all the members of our family, the outsiders will know that peace is in our house.

Friends, do you know what the disease paralysis is? Paralytics are those whose one side is weekened so that it cannot support itself. They

cannot walk. They cannot do anything except lie on the bed. On that day four persons carried a paralytic man on his bed. They had faith that Jesus will heal this diseased person. But they could not take this patient to Jesus due to large crowd. They had the desire to take this sick man before Jesus somehow. Finally, they decided to remove the ceiling (tiles) of the house and lower the patient before Jesus.

In those days, the roofs of the houses were flat and could be removed easily. They took the sick man to the top of the house through outside stairs. They opened a portion of the roof. They then tied a rope to the four corners of the bed and lowered him with the bed before Jesus. Jesus seeing the faith of the people who brought the sick person said him, "Arise and walk with your bed". Miraculous! People there could not believe their eyes. The sick man arose in front of everybody and walked along with his bed praising the God. Everybody was very much astonished to see this. "We have never seen such a healing before this", said the people and glorified God.

Friends, we should be capable of bringing the sick person or those who are in trouble to Jesus. It is our responsibility to pray and help when our relatives or friends are sick or in problems. We should introduce them to Jesus.

Summary: God hears our prayers when we pray with faith.





hand too. They are blind people. They cannot do anything without the help of others. Today we are going to study about such a person whom Jesus

met.

#### **Detailed**

#### Lesson:

There was a

blind man named

Barthimaeus son of Thimaeus in

Jericho city. As he was not capable to do anything, he lived by begging.

Friends, have you seen blind people begging on the road sides? How pitiable is their life? Friends, do you know how blind people understand that somebody is near them? (Let the children





answer). Oh, right right, by hearing the sound. Isn't it? When they hear the sound, they ask for money.

Barthimaeus used to live by the coins given by people as alms. God's children like us should help others. But Barthimaeus had a strong desire to get eyesight.

Once, Jesus with his disciples followed by a big crowd came to a city named Jericho. Barthimaeus was seated on the side of the road through which Jesus was passing. Listening to the great noise of the crowd, Barthimaeus enquired about it from the people. He understood that Jesus is passing through and He heals all disease. Barthimaeus immediately started crying loudly, "Jesus, son of David, have mercy on me".

When people heard the cries of Barthimaeus, they told him to keep quiet. But he continued to cry "Jesus, son of David, have mercy on me". "What should I do for you", Jesus asked him. He said, "I need sight". Jesus said, "Go, you have got sight". Instantly he got sight. Barthimaeus' wish was to follow Jesus who had given him sight. So, he followed Jesus cheerfully. Like Barthimaeus followed Jesus, we must also follow Him as only Jesus can do miracles in our life.

**Summary:** Jesus can do any miracle. He does not abandon the one who prays to Him.





very dear to the Centurion. The servant who was paralytic and suffering from much pain might have had treatment under many doctors. But friends, do you know what disease is paralysis? A condition when part of the body is without movement and feeling and the person cannot rise up from bed is called paralysis. Such patients have pain too. Inspite of

changing medicines from time to time, the pain kept on increasing instead of healing. During this period, the Centurion knew that Jesus is coming to that place.

The Centurion who knew that Jesus heals the sick sent some of his Jewish elders to Jesus. This army captain was a gentile. Friends, do you know who are gentiles? Those who are not Jews were called gentiles.

The Jewish elders went to Jesus and told him about the Captain's servant earnestly. They also told Jesus that this Centurion had got them a Synagogue built and he loved their people very much and therefore worthy to do this.

Jesus went to the Centurion's house along with those people. When he was approaching the house, the Centurion sent some of his friends to Jesus and told like this, "Lord Jesus, I am not a worthy person for you to come to my house. I believe that if you say a word, my servant will be healed". Jesus marvelled to at these words. Jesus told those who were following him, "I have not found so great faith, no, not in Israel". Then he told the Centurion, "Go your way, and as you have believed, so be it done to you". Instantly the servant of the captain was healed. When the friends of the captain returned home, they found the servant totally healed.

**Summary:** Those who believe will be healed. Jesus is always ready to help them.



over demons.


Memory Verse:

Introduction: Friends, have you seen people walking on the street with torn clothes, untidy and long hair and talking to themselves? Do you know as to what these people are called? They are called mad people. Once, a mad man happened to see Jesus. We will learn about that event today.

**Detailed Lesson:** Once, Jesus came to a place called the land of Gadarenes on the shore of the sea at the other side of the sea of Galilee. The disciples were also with him. When they were coming from the seashore, a man came running





a graveyard. The place where dead bodies are buried is called cemetery or a graveyard. He lived among the tombs in the graveyard. He used to cry loudly, run here and there around the tombs and wounded himself. Friends, do you know why he did so? He became mad because devils entered his body.

The demon possessed man fell on the feet of Jesus and cried loudly and prayed, "Oh Jesus, son of God, don't punish me". Jesus stared at him and commanded the demon in him, "Unclean spirit, leave this man and go away". Jesus asked the man as to what was his name. He answered that his name was Legion. A large group of demons is called Legion. The demons requested Jesus not to send out them from this man.

At the end, they said that if they have to be sent out, they should be sent into the herd of pigs that was being fed near the hillside. Jesus allowed that. The unclean spirits entered in to the pigs. The herd of pigs into which the demons had entered ran fast and fell into the sea and died. The pigs were about two thousand. The workers feeding the pigs told about this to everybody. People came to Jesus to see all that had happened.

Friends, do you know what happened to the man from whom the demons departed? His madness was healed. Now he was in his right mind. He wore good clothes. Due to the change in him, others feared God. When Jesus wanted to return, this man asked permission from Jesus to follow him. But He did not allow him. Jesus said, "Go to your home and tell the family all what the Lord has done to you". Accordingly he went to his hometown at Decapolis and witnessed for Jesus.

**Summary:** The wind and sea obeyed Jesus' words. The sick were healed. Jesus has authority not only over nature and diseases but also on demons.







are aware of the wells in houses. A pool is larger than a well and contains more water. Bethesda was a pool in which miracles happened. At certain times, the angel of God would come and stir the water. When the water was stirred, whoever got down in the pool first was instantly healed of whatever disease he had. Therefore many people lay down and waited at Bethesda for the water to be stirred to get healed.

Jesus came to this pool. He saw a sick man lying down there for 38 years. Jesus felt compassion on the man. Jesus asked him, "Do you want to be healed". He told Jesus about his difficulty that he is not able to get down first when pool is stirred up. Others get down themselves or with the help of others and get healed. There was nobody to help this sick person. He was not strong enough to go by himself. By the time he crawled and reached the pool, somebody else would go before him and get healed. Jesus healed him. Friends, similarly when we have nobody to help or when we are weak, Jesus has the will to help us.

Jesus told him to rise up and carry his bed. As he was lying by the pool for a long time, he had a bed. Instantly he rose up and picked up his bed and walked. The people who had gathered there to celebrate the feast came to know about this miracle. The man who was sick for 38 years was very happy to get healed. He thanked God and went to his house.

Summary: Jesus has the will to heal any of our diseases.





Aim

To create the feeling in the children that Jesus has the

authority to raise the dead.

**Memory Verse:** 

John 11:25 – I am the resurrection, and the life.

**Introduction**: Friends, have you gone to a house where death has taken place? There would be grief and cries in such house. Isn't it? The dead leave us and will never return. But long ago Jesus raised a dead man. We will study as to how that happened.

**Detailed Lesson:** In a place called Bethany, three persons -two sisters named Martha, Mary and their brother Lazarus lived. They were the friends of Jesus. Bethany was very near to Jerusalem. When Jesus used to pass by that way, He often visited them. They used to receive Jesus lovingly and offer hospitality.

Being so, one day Lazarus became sick. The disease became serious.


Martha and Mary immediately sent some people to Jesus and informed him that their brother is seriously ill. Lazarus' sisters had great faith in Jesus. They thought that Jesus will come and heal their brother. But inspite of knowing this Jesus stayed where he was for two more days.

Jesus loved Lazarus.

Jesus knew what would

Jesus loved Lazarus. Jesus knew what would happen to Lazarus and what He do would to him. When the right time came, Jesus reached Bethany along with his disciples. By that time Lazarus had died and four days had passed.

Friends, you might have gone to a house where someone has died, Isn't it? Many people come there. Like this, many people had gathered in that house to comfort Martha and Mary.





Among them were relatives, friends and church members. When Martha came to know that Jesus is coming, she ran to meet Him. But Mary sat at home. Martha said to Jesus, "Jesus, if you had been here my brother would not have died". Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life". He that believes in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live". Jesus asked about Mary who was still at home. Jesus stood outside the

village where Martha had met Him. Martha told Mary, "The Master has come and He is calling you".

When Mary came to know that Jesus was searching for her, she arose quickly and went to Him. Without knowing all these things which were going on, the people gathered at the house also came with her. Seeing Jesus, Mary fell at his feet. "Lord if you had been here my brother would not have died", she wept. Seeing that Martha, Mary and the other people weeping, Jesus also wept. Dear friends, Jesus understands our situations of joy and sadness. Jesus rejoices as well as becomes sad with us.

Jesus asked about where was Lazarus was buried. They took him to the grave. A huge stone was kept at the mouth of the Tomb. Friends, do you know what a tomb is? A tomb is a place made to bury the dead by the Jews. The tomb is cut out in stone like a cave. It is covered with a huge stone. Jesus told the people gathered there to remove the stone. Seeing this Martha told "Lord, it is now four days since Lazarus has died. It may be smelling bad". Jesus told her "If you would believe you will see the glory of God". Jesus looked at heaven and prayed. After the prayer, Jesus called loudly, "Lazarus, come forth". Miraculous! The dead Lazarus came out. Lazarus was wrapped in clothes. Jesus told the people "Loose him, and let him go'. They got back Lazarus alive.

**Summary:** There is nothing which cannot be done by Jesus. He can heal the sick and raise the dead because Jesus is God.

To make the children aware that Jesus is the good



**Memory Verse**: Luke 15:24 - For this Son of mine was dead, and is alive again, he was lost, and is found.

**Introduction:** Friends, how much do you love your Papa and Mummy? You obey what they say, don't you? But sometimes you disobey them, right? Then they scold you and sometimes even punish you. But we again love our parents and they lovingly caress us. Parents will never abandon us. Like this, today we are going to learn about the parable of a son who returned to his father, as told by Jesus.

**Detailed Lesson:** A long time back there was a rich man living in a certain place. He had two sons. They grew up to be smart. There was no lack of anything in that house. While they were living so happily, the younger son wanted to have more freedom. He did not like to obey his father. He desired to live freely according to his will. Thus, he went to his father and asked for his share of the wealth (inheritance). The loving father gave him his share. Very soon, he sold off all that was

Very soon, he sold off all that was his and went away to a city in a far land with the money. There he started living freely without being contr-olled by





any-body. There he got some bad friends. Thus they lived eating, drinking and doing wrong things. Within few days, the money that he had was over. When the money was over, his friends left him one by one. The poor son! He was left alone without anyone. He had no food for his hunger and was starving.

There occurred a famine in the land. Friends, have you understood what is famine? Don't know. Isn't it? The condition of not having adequate food even while having money is called famine. Then this son approached a farmer there and asked for a job. He gave this son the job of feeding pigs and sent him to the field. In those days, people used to rear pigs in herds. Though rearing of pigs is not a decent job, he accepted the same not happily as he could not do anything else. As he did not get sufficient food to eat, many times he wanted to eat the food given to pigs. But he did not get that too.

He went many days tired with hunger and thirst. He hated the life with pigs. Then he remembered his father. He recalled that his servants at home ate and wasted the rest. But he was starving here. He could not bear the sorrow. At the end he took a decision. I will die here. I will return to my father and ask for pardon and live like a servant.

Thus, he started his journey back to his father's house. He was thin due to hunger, his clothes were old and torn, with long and not properly combed hair and was in an unrecognizable and tired state. But the father recognized his son coming from afar and ran to him, hugged and kissed him. Both of them cried. The son asked for pardon. The father rejoiced on return of his lost son. He received him as his son. He was given new clothes. A grand feast was organised and rejoiced with everyone.

**Summary:** If we have committed mistakes and gone far from God but return to Him seeking pardon, our God will receive us lovingly.





To make the children aware that God delights in those


who help the needy and it is our duty to help those who are in trouble.

Introduction: Friends, you might have seen on TV or read in newspapers about people helping the wounded in an accident, etc. to reach hospitals. Similarly you might have seen the rescue operations at the accident spots. Like this, Jesus said about an incident in which a man helped a person who had met with an accident. We are going to learn about that incident today.

**Detailed Lesson:** One day Jesus was talking to the people, who surrounded him, about the Word of God when a scribe came to him. Scribe means a Jewish Scholar and Teacher. He asked Jesus, "Master, what shall I do to get eternal life"? Friends, do you know what is eternal life? Eternal life means the life after our death in heaven with God forever and ever. Once, a man was travelling from Jerusalem to Jericho. The path he travelled was very dangerous. Thieves used to hide by the way. They often attacked the travellers and stole their money and material. Similarly, this traveller was also attacked. He was wounded. His clothes and everything he had were stolen and they left him on the way. After sometime

a Priest went that way. Friends, do you know who a Priest is? Priest is a person who serves in the Holy Temple. Seeing the wounded man, he passed by the other way. The Priest did not try to help the wounded.

Then, a Levite, who helps in the Temple, also went through this way. He too passed by without helping the wounded. After sometime, a Samaritan came that way. He had compassion on the wounded man. He went to him. He applied medicine on his wound and dressed them. Then he set him on his beast and took him to a nearby Inn.

The Samaritan stayed with the wounded man in the Inn for a day and took care of him. The next day when the Samaritan was departing for his work, he called the owner of the Inn and gave him a certain amount of money. "Take care of this man, whatever you will spend on him in excess, I will give it to you on my return", said the Samaritan.

Jesus asked, "Which of the three was the best neighbour to this man who was wounded by the attack of thieves". "The one showed mercy on him", answered the Scribe. "Go and do likewise", said Jesus.

**Summary:** We must help those who are in danger. We love our neighbours around us by helping them in their needs.







Memory Verse:


Mathew 13:37 – The one who sows the good seed is

#### **Detailed Lesson:**

One day as usual Jesus was surrounded by a large crowd. When people from nearby regions also gathered, Jesus spoke parable of the sower. Friends do you know who is a sower? A farmer is a sower. He is a person who sows in his field. One morning, the so-wer started sowing his seed. Friends, have you seen wheat grains? Wheat is a grain like rice. While sowing some seeds of the wheat fell on. the way-side. People walk-ed over it and des-troyed and it became useless. Besides this the birds also ate it.





Some seeds fell on the rock. Though it came up in few days but due to lack of water and soil, when sun rose, they dried away. While sowing, some seeds fell among thorns. These seeds grew up but the thorns choked them and they were no more. They could not grow and give fruit. But some seeds fell on the good ground. They seeds grew and

gave the yield as expected by the farmer. Those wheat plants grew; become ears and gave a hundredfold yield. Jesus told this parable to the people and said, "Who has ears to hear, let him hear".

Friends, have your understood the meaning of this parable? Not understood. Isn't it? Like this, the disciples of Jesus also could not understand the meaning. They asked Jesus what is the meaning of this parable. He told them the meaning of the parable - Seed is the Word of God. Seeds falling on the wayside are about the people who hear the Word of God. But the hearing of the words did not benefit them because they did not seriously try to keep it in their heart. The seeds that fell on the rock meant that the people received it with joy. As they had no roots, though they believed instantly, when a small problem came, they left it. The one fallen among thorns means, the people who cheerfully received the word of God but it was chocked due to the thoughts, riches, luxury and pleasures of the world that it could not give the perfect fruit. The seeds which fell on the good ground are the one wherein the seed was received in a honest and good heart and brought forth good fruit to the Lord.

**Summary:** Dear friends, God's expectation from us is that the seed of His Words should fall in our honest and good heart and give a perfect fruit like in the parable told by Jesus where the sower sowed the seeds in the good field and they gave a good yield.

Jesus, like the seed that fell on the good field and gave good fruit, help me also so that the seed of the Word of God which falls in my heart may give good fruit. Amen.






