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Lesson 1 PHARAOH: THE ENEMY OF GOD'S PEOPLE



Reference: Exodus 1:8-22

Aim: To make the children aware that God increases, protects and provides for His people even during their persecution by rulers.

Memory Verse: Exodus 1:7—And the children of Israel were fruitful, and increased abundantly, and multiplied, and waxed exceeding mighty; and the land was filled with them

Introduction: Friends, you might have seen labourer working in the sun. They work very hard, isn't it? They get money in the evening. Today we are going to learn about those people who worked hard but did not get any reward.

Detailed Lesson: Do you remember the story of Joseph studied in Class 1? Can any of you tell? Right, Right. Joseph is the man

whom his brothers had put in to the pit; sold to

the merchants and was sent from Potiphar's house to the jail; then interpreted the meaning

of dream of the King; and was raised to the position of prime

minister of Egypt.

You may be recalling the name of his father. Don't you? The name of his father is Jacob. When Jacob became the prime minister of Egypt, his father and brothers came to Egypt and settled there. Jacob was given another name 'Israel' by God. The Israel multiplied in the country and became a big community.

The rulers of Egypt were called 'Pharaoh'. After the death of Pharaoh who was ruling at the time of Joseph, another Pharaoh became the king of Egypt who did not know Joseph.





When the people of Israel multiplied, the Pharaoh thought that he may lose his kingdom and the nation. One day he proclaimed an order. Friends, do you know what it was? The command was to give the Israelites more tough work. The king thought that he can ruin the Israelites in this manner.

He appointed taskmasters over Israelites. The taskmasters beat them and made them work very hard. They put them building treasure cities and big buildings for the king. But the Israelites grew more and more even during this trouble. Friends, do you know what type of work they did? Have you seen bricks used for building house? The Israelites were engaged in making bricks. Bricks are made of mud burning in fire. They were asked to make bricks without giving wood for fire. If the number of bricks made is less, the taskmasters would beat them cruelly. They were not given proper food and rest. Thus their life became miserable.

God doesn't like making anybody suffer or put anybody to work hard. Whatever is not liked by God is sin. God punishes who does sin.

Unsatisfied with this, the king also brought out another rule. The new rule was that all the male children born to Israelites should be thrown in to Nile River and killed. Lots of male children were thrown in to this river which was full of crocodiles. All the Israel started praying to God. Thus, God heard the prayers of Israel. Friends, God hears our prayers. If we pray to God in troubles, He will help us.

God who heard the prayers of the Israelites decided to help them. Only God can help in our problems. We will learn in the next standards as to how God has helped them.

Conclusion: God heard the prayers of Israelites who were in trouble. Likewise, He will hear our prayers too.



Lesson 2 MOSES: THE ONE DRAWN OUT OF WATER



Reference: Exodus 2:1-10

Aim: To make the children aware that God protect and provide us more than that of our parents.

Memory Verse: Psalms 46:1 - God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

Introduction: Friends, do you love small kids? You love to kiss and play with them. What about if you come to know that a baby is going to be born in your house? You would jump up with joy with this news? Today we are going to learn about the story of the birth of a baby in a house long ago.

Detailed Lesson: A very fair child was born to Amram and Jocabed, one of the parents from God's own people. He was their third child. The child was very fair. It was a day of joy for his elder brother Aaron and Sister Miriam.

But the parents were sad and afraid because the child was born at a time when there was a mandate from

They put a tiny pillow and bed inside the box and laid the child in it. This small family kissed the baby one by one. They put the box in the brink of Nile River.

Nile River is full of crocodiles. Therefore, Miriam, the sister of the child waited far off to see what would happen to the child. When Miriam was hiding, the daughter of king Pharaoh and her maids came to the river for bath. They were amazed to see the box lying between the bushes. They took out the box and opened the lid. They could not believe their eyes. A very fair male child is lying in the box. The Princess felt compassion on him. She decided to take care of him. Friends, it is the God who delivers us from death. Reference: Exodus 3:1; 4:1-17, 27-31


Aim: To convince the children that we should obey God than







Lesson 5 MOSES BEFORE THE PHARAOH

Reference: Exodus 5:1-23; 6:1-9; 7:1-13

Aim: To make the children aware that when one has decided to obey God, they should act courageously without fearing others.

Memory Verse: 2 Chronicles 19:11(b) – Deal courageously, and the LORD be with the good.

Introduction: Friends, have you seen a palace? The man who sits there on a throne and governs the people is called King. In earlier times, the kings (Monarchy) ruled the world. During one such period of monarchy, God asked Moses to go to a king.

Detailed Lesson: According to the command of God, Moses started his journey from Midian to the palace of Pharaoh in order to free the Israelites. He got his brother Aaron as companion. Thereafter they travelled together. Now they were more courageous and stirred up. Thus they reached the palace of Pharaoh.

Moses and Aaron asked Pharaoh to let the Israelites go for a three days journey in to the wilderness to worship their God. Pharaoh mocked the God of Israel and said "Who is the Lord that I should obey his voice to let Israel go? I know not the Lord, neither will I let Israel go". Pharaoh refused to let the Israelites go.

Pharaoh not only refused to let Israelites go but also got angry with Moses and Aaron. He thought that the Israelites have become lazy and that is why they are telling to go to sacrifice to their God. Therefore, the king told the taskmasters to increase the burden on the Israelites. Pharaoh told them not to give straw to make bricks and let Israelites go and gather





it for themselves. He also commanded that the number of bricks should not be diminished. The Israelites misunderstood that it is because of Moses and Aaron that Pharaoh started burdening them more. They murmured against Moses and Aaron and also got angry on them. Moses too was sad on this.

Dear Friends, the Lord does not like finding fault of His servants. Whatever is not liked by God is sin. Moses told God about the complaints of people. The Lord told Moses, "I am the Lord and God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. I will set you free from the bondage. I will take you to the Promised Land. Therefore, you have to again go to Pharaoh.

Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh again. They demanded to Pharaoh to let the people go to worship their God. Pharaoh asked Moses to show a sign so as to prove that God has sent them. Aaron put his rod on the floor. Miraculous! It became a serpent. The magicians of Pharaoh also did the same thing. But the serpent of Aaron swallowed the serpents of the magicians.

Friends, when Aaron put his rod on the floor, it became a serpent as commanded by Lord earlier. They did it as per God's command. God never turns back from His promises. Therefore, we should trust God.

Pharaoh did not let the people free inspite of seeing the miracle. However, Moses and Aaron again stood before the king courageously. If we stand for God courageously, He will help us. Later, Pharaoh let the people go. We will learn about the same in the next class.

Conclusion : Our God always keeps His words. Therefore, we should work for Him courageously.

Lesson 6 GOD DELIVERS HIS PEOPLE FROM EGYPT



Reference: Exodus 7:14 and up to chapter 12

Aim: To make the children understand that if we cry to our God and obey him, He will certainly set us free from the enemy.

Memory Verse: Exodus 2:23(b) and they cried, and their cry came up unto God by reason of the bondage.

Introduction: Friends, have you ever travelled? Surely yes, isn't it? When we plan to travel with Papa and Mummy, we prepare for the same many days before the journey. Today we are going to learn about the preparation for a journey.

Detailed Lesson: We have been learning in the last lessons about the sufferings of Israelites under bondage. God used Moses as a part of His plan to deliver the Israelites.

Moses went to Pharaoh and demanded him to send the Israelite to worship their God. Pharaoh did not allow. Moreover he burdened them with more work. The dejected Moses went to the presence of God when He told him that Pharaoh will be afflicted with plagues; but he will not let the people free; that God will punish Pharaoh with heavy burdens; then he will let the people go out of Egypt. God sent ten plagues to Pharaoh and his people. But, the plagues did not affect the place where the Israelites were living. All these were done because our God is Almighty.

The water became blood: When Moses stretched the rod, all the waters in the river became blood. The Egyptians suffered a lot to get drinking water.

Frogs: When Moses stretched the rod, thousands of frogs entered in to the palace and other places.

Lice: When Moses smote the dust of the earth, it became lice in large amount and it started biting man on the entire body and head.



Fly: The next day God sent swarms of flies to Egypt. It started pricking Pharaoh and his people.

Murrain: Another day, all the cattle in Egypt died due to a unusual disease.

The boil: Moses sprinkled the ashes of the furnace. Suddenly, boil appeared on men, animal and all the land of Egypt.

Hail: When Moses stretched his hands, hail started from heaven. Along with hail, thunder and fire also came down from sky. The men and animals in the field were killed.

Locusts: Locusts spread over the land and it ate all the vegetation.

Thick Darkness: There was thick darkness in the entire Egypt for three days. However, there was light for the Israelites.

All these plagues did not affect the Israelites. Pharaoh kept on saying during each of the plague that he will let the Israelites go. But when the plague disappears with the prayer of Moses, he stopped the people from leaving. God punished Pharaoh for testing Him. It is sin to test our God.

Killing of the first born: This was the tenth plague. All the first born, the one in the palace to the servant hutment including the first born of animals were killed. There was a great cry over the land of Egypt. The destroyer did not come to the Israelites as they killed the lamp and stroke its blood on the door post of their houses as told by God. If we obey God, we will be saved.

Pharaoh called Moses and allowed the Israelite to go. The entire Israel proceeded to Canaan to where God promised them to give.

Conclusion: Under the leadership of Moses, God delivered the Israelites who were under bondage for long years. God's people were delivered from the clutches of Pharaoh by His mighty hands.







Lesson 7 THE JOURNEY THROUGH THE SEA




Reference: Exodus 14:1-31

Aim: To make the children aware that there may be troubles in our journey ahead but God can solve all of them.

Memory Verse: Exodus 14:22 – And the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea upon the dry ground: and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.

Introduction: Friends, have you ever seen a sea? How many of you have taken bath in it? You might have felt that the water would drown us. Today we are going to learn about the journey through the sea.





heard a big shout. Friends, have you seen any war of the earlier period? You must have watched on the TV. Isn't it? Like that, a big army on horses and chariots with sword and shield was approaching the people to hold them. The Israelites used to do all the jobs in Egypt. Therefore Pharaoh wanted to take back the people to do the jobs.

The Israelites started crying. But Moses inspired them. Moses stretched his hands over the sea as told by God. Miraculous! God caused to flow a strong east wind over the sea and divided the sea in to two. The middle part became dry land. All Israelites crossed the sea safely through this dry path and reached the other shore.




Reference: Exodus 15:22-27; 16:1-36

After few weeks of journey, their food stock exhausted. They started complaining to Moses and started murmuring against him. Murmuring against Moses is like murmuring against God as Moses is the servant of

God. Friends, murmuring against God is sin.

God said to Moses that bread will rain from tomorrow morning. It has to be collected every day. In the evening birds came together where the Israelites were dwelling. The Israelites caught the birds flying at very low height and cooked them and ate in abundance. In the morning dew was lying around their camp. When the dew gone up, they saw a thing like fish scale lying on the earth.

Friends, have you eaten bread with honey? Your mouth is watering. Isn't it? The taste of this food was exactly like this. They called it 'Manna'. God commanded to them that it should be gathered every day morning at one litre per person. Some collected more, some less. When they measured, each person got same quantity of Manna. Some kept it for next day. But it bred worms and stank. God had told them to gather it only for a day's need. But when they collect Manna on the sixth day, they could do it for the next day also as the seventh day was Sabbath. On this day the Israelites worship God. On that day everyone was to worship God without doing any work. Friends, when do you go for church meetings? It is on Sunday. Isn't it? On Sundays, we should go to Church for praising our God.

The Israelite ate this Manna throughout 40 years till they reached Canaan. Dear friends, if we obey the commands of God, He will bless us.

Conclusion: God protect His children and provide them food according to our needs.

Lesson 10 KORAH AND HIS GROUP ARE BEING PUNISHED



Reference: Numbers 16:1-35

Aim: To make the children aware that rebellion with servants of God is a wrong which deserves punishment.

Memory Verse: Proverbs 29:1 - He, that being often reproved hardeneth his neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.

Introduction: Friends have you heard through newspaper about sinking of wells? At some places, the earth claves in to two parts after an earth quake. Those who fall in to such clave cannot escape but get killed. Today we are going to

learn about such an incident where the earth split

in to two parts and certain people died in it.

Detailed Lesson: The Israelites were continuing their journey towards Canaan. Inspite of passing many years, they could not reach the destination. Moses had started the journey telling them that they would be taken to Canaan where milk and honey flows. At this time, some people started murmuring against Moses and Aaron. Moses and Aaron were leading them. God spoke to the people through Moses. But there were certain people who did not accept the leadership of Moses.

Korah, Dathan and Abiram were the main persons who rebelled against Moses and Aaron. They gathered some 250 renowned men in their favour. They argued that they too are holy men and the Lord is among them. They put the allegation that Moses and Aaron are lifting themselves up.

Friends, it is a sin to talk against the servants appointed by God. God punishes the sin.

Hearing this, Moses fell upon the face before the God and prayed. Moses put before them a



test to identify as to by whom God want to lead the Israelites. Korah and his group were told to come the next day carrying their censers before the Tabernacle, the temple of God. Censer is an article held by the priest. God was angry to see Korah and his group holding the censers. God decided to punish them.

Dear friends, God punish judiciously. God judges according to the work of each one. If the work is good, He gives reward and if it is bad he punishes.

God said to Moses and Aaron "separate yourselves from among this congregation, that I may consume them in a moment". Moses prayed to God for the people. He pleaded not to destroy the entire people for the sin of one person. God heard this prayer. He commanded the people to separate from the tents of Korah, Dathan and Abiram. Friends, it would help us to be saved if we separate from those who rebel against the God.

Moses told the people, I have not hurt anyone. I have obeyed what God told me to do. You will come to know that I have been sent by God do all these work. By the following action you will come to know that I have not done of my own. Suddenly, the land where Korah and his group were standing split. The land swallowed all those and their family who rebelled against Moses and Aaron. They went under the earth with great cry. The people got afraid seeing all these. Those 250 princes stood along with Korah were burnt by the fire sent from God's presence.

Conclusion: God punishes those who question His spiritual servants. We should be submissive to the servants of God instead of being rebellious.



Memory Verse: Proverbs 1:7 - The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom.



Lesson 13 THE SON OF WIDOW IS BEING RESURRECTED




Reference: 1 King 17:17-24

Conclusion: If we rely on God, He will convert our sorrow in to cheer. God can do great work through His obedient children.







and told him in



regarding prophet Elisha about whom we studied in the last lesson. Oh, right. You remember. The children who mocked Elisha were killed by bear. Isn't it? Friends, can you tell as to whose disciple Elisha was? He was the disciple of Prophet Elijah.

Likewise, a disciple of Elisha died due to deadly disease. He had wife and two children.

The prophet had borrowed money from many for the need of the family. But he died before he could repay it. At this time, those who lent the money came to the house of the prophet and started troubling them. One day some people came and tried to take both the children. Somehow they managed to escape. The poor mother rushed to Prophet Elisha and explained the whole matter.



Prophet Elisha felt sympathetic of her. "What do you have in your house"? He asked her. Nothing except some oil in the bottle, she said. Elisha told her to go and borrow as many empty vessels from neighbours. Friends, our God give us prosperity. Now please listen as to how the wonder had happened.

The mother reached home and told everything to the children that told by Elisha. They were very happy. They borrowed as many utensils as could. They got inside the room, shut the door and started pouring the oil in to the borrowed utensils. The filled utensils were kept separately. When all the utensils were filled, the flow of the oil stopped.

The family cheered up with joy. They went and told Elisha what had happened. He told them to sell the oil and pay the debt and look after the needs of the family with the balance left.

Dear friends, it will be a blessing for us if we obey what the servants of God tell us.

Conclusion: God knows the need of their servants. He will help their families.







Reference: 2 Kings 5:1-14


Aim: To make the children understand that we should tell about our God to others wherever we are.

Anyway due to the persuasion by his companions, Naaman decided to wash in Jordan. He dipped the first time and looked at his body. He thought little healing would have occurred. But there was no change. He dipped for the second, third, fourth, fifth and the sixth time. Nothing happened. However, when he dipped for the seventh time, his body became like body of children. The leprosy was completely cleaned. Naaman got complete healing. Naaman wondered and came to the house of the Prophet to thank him and then returned to his country.

Friends, Our God heals. If we obey to His word, we will be blessed.

Conclusion: Naaman got healed as the little girl shared about God's prophet. Like this, we should also share about our God to others.

Reference: Daniel: 6:1-28





Reference: Luke 2:41-51

He was sitting and listening to the sermons being given and was clearing his doubts on the word of God. Mary got relieved when she saw Jesus. They asked Jesus, Son why did you do like this to us? We were so worried about you. Jesus replied to them "How is it that ye sought me? Don't you know that I must be about my Father's business"? The reason is that Jesus was the Son of the heavenly Father. Jesus is born as the redeemer of this world. It is a sin if we do not acknowledge the birth of Jesus is for our salvation.






John the Baptist to prepare the way for fulfilling the worldly mission of Jesus Christ, the Son of our heavenly King.







Aim: The children should have knowledge about the contents of Jesus' sermon of mount. To make the children understand that they should obey the doctrines of the sermon of mount.



Jesus preached that the peacemakers are blessed and only those will be called the children of God. When others try to break peace, we should try to bring peace among them. What does Jesus mean by this? Friends, will you do what Jesus taught us?

Then Jesus compared the believers with salt. Friends, can you tell the quality of salt? (Let the children answer). Right. Salt provide good taste. Jesus expects from us that we all should bring tastes to the community.

Another important expectation of Jesus is that we should become light for those who are living in darkness.

The Lord taught many such different doctrines. If we live according to these, we will be blessed. Friends, are you ready for it?

By obeying these commands, we are doing the will of God. Jesus commanded that people obeying him shall only enter in to the kingdom of God.

Conclusion: We are duty bound to obey to the commands of Jesus Christ. Then only we will be saved.





Reference: Luke 17:11-19


Aim: To make the children understand that God want us to be grateful to Him for His avours and also to the favours of men.

Memory Verse: Ephesians 5:20 - Giving thanks always for all things unto God and ne Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Introduction: What do we say when somebody does a favour to us. We say nanks. Isn't it? It means 'grateful'. If we do not say this, people will think as if we are nankless. Like this, we are going to learn today about an incident where a person ame to pay his gratitude for the favour he received from Jesus Christ.

Nobody help or love these hated patients. At this time, these 10 lepers came to know that the Lord who heals is coming to that place. As these patients were not allowed to come to the crowd, seeing Jesus coming from

a distance, they started crying loudly "Jesus our Lord, have mercy on us".

Hearing the cries of the lepers, Jesus stopped and talked to them. Friends, Jesus has dealt with even such downtrodden people mercifully, touched and healed them who are hated by community and reluctant to deal with. Jesus understood their need to be get healed told them to go the temple to show themselves to the priests. Friends, do you know why Jesus told them like that? Don't know. Isn't it? There was a law that a leper who is healed was to be shown to the priests and certified by them to prove their healing. After getting such proof, community would accept them.

While going to the Temple, all of them got healing. Out of the ten, only one leper came back, fell before Jesus, thanked Him and also glorified the God. The other nine did not do like this. 

Friends, do you remember learning about another similar





disease with which people were not allowed to come to large crowds. Right, right. You are aware. It is leprosy. In any case, this lady determined to go to Jesus.

This lady who was sick for 12 years spent all her earnings on doctors for its treatment. At that time she heard about Jesus. She trusted that Jesus is the God who heals. She reached to Jesus pushing and pulling the crowd and touched the garment of Jesus. Miraculous! At once, she felt the healing in her body. At this time, Jesus felt power of healing flowing from Him and looked around. He asked as to who has touched His cloth. His disciples told "Teacher, why you are asking as to who has touched you from the big crowd".

Jesus again looked around. "The power has flown from me. Who has touched me", Jesus asked again. When the lady found that she cannot hide it any more, she fell on the feet of Jesus and told everything to Him. Dear friends, Jesus knows everything. We cannot do anything hiding from Him.

Jesus told the healed lady, "Daughter you may go. Your faith has delivered you" and sent her home with peace.

Reference: Mark 11:1-10


Aim: To make the children aware that it is our duty to praise and worship Jesus.







Conclusion: We all are very valuable to God. Jesus came to the world in search of us, the lost one. When we obey God, it gives great joy to God.





Conclusion: God has given each one of us different capabilities. We must find it out and utilise rightly. God doesn't like those who are lazy and say that they do not have any capability.





Reference: Mark 5:21-24; 35-43

Aim: To make the children aware that Jesus is the God who raises the dead.

Reference: Mathew 27:1-50


Aim: To make the children understand that Jesus Christ died on the cross for our sins; that if we believe in Jesus, our sins will be forgiven and we will become the children of God.

Memory Verse: Mathew 27:50 - Jesus cried again with a loud voice and yielded up his spirit.

Introduction: Friends, Did you ever have a wound on your body? We feel pain when we are wounded. We are going to learn about Jesus Christ who was wounded for us.

Detailed Lesson: After the Passover festival of Jews, Jesus and his disciples again gathered and had supper. Jesus told them that the next day he will be crucified and one of them would betray him. It was the disciple named Judas. He immediately left them. After the supper, Jesus went to mount Olive. There Jesus prayed in the garden of Bethsaida.

Before His crucifixion, Jesus talked to God for long time through prayers. He was getting himself ready to die for the mankind. When Jesus finished the prayer, as said by Him earlier, Judas and his group came to catch Him. Judas kissed Jesus. Judas had told beforehand to the Roman soldiers that whomsoever I kiss would be Jesus. Dear friends, the





reason for Judas to betray Jesus, with whom he lived and listened to His words, was the money that the enemy of Jesus gave him. They gave them 30 silver coins. But when Judas came to know that Jesus was crucified, he felt guilty, went and hanged himself. Very sad, it all happened due to his greed. Dear friends, greed is a sin.

The soldiers caught Jesus and took to the Chief Priest. Thereafter He was taken to the governor, Pilate. He interrogated Jesus. But he could not find any fault in Jesus. However, the crowd has been crying for crucifying Jesus, he ordered to crucify Jesus.

The soldiers beat Him with whip very cruelly. A crown of thrones was forced into his head. It started bleeding from the wounds. When Jesus was writhing in with pain, the soldiers put a heavy cross made of pine wood on His shoulder. They made Jesus to walk from the governor's house to the hill of Golgotha where He was to be crucified. He fell and rise with the cross again and again and finally reached the hill of Golgotha. The soldiers laid Jesus on the cross. Both of His hands were spread over to the cross and nailed. His legs were joined and large nails were put on the hands and legs of Jesus. Jesus writhed in pain; they crucified Jesus between two thieves. In the cross Jesus gave His life in to the hands of God saying "it is finished".

Conclusion:

Reference: Mathew 27:5 28:1-10

Aim: To make the children understand that the crucified Jesus was died, buried and resurrected. Our Jesus is still alive.

Memory Verse: Mathew 28:7(a) - He is risen from the dead.

Introduction: Friends, have you ever gone to attend a burial service? Normally the dead body is kept in tomb in the church and cover it with soil. In the earlier times, the tomb is carved in rocks like a small cave. The rich people used to get such tombs made. Jesus was buried in such a tomb.

Detailed Lesson: In the last lesson we studied about Jesus who was crucified between two thieves. Jesus died saying "it is finished". Suddenly the earth did quake. Rocks rent. Graves were opened. Jesus recalled these words. They went and told these things to Pilate. Pilate gave them soldiers. They went and sealed the tomb and also kept them to watch it.

On the third day after the death of Jesus, two of His woman disciples went to see the tomb and also to put incense over it. The tomb was closed with a large stone. This stone could have been moved only if many strong people try to do it. Therefore these women were talking as to who will remove the stone.

Suddenly an earth-quake occurred. An angel from heaven descended and rolled out the stone and sat on it. The soldiers seeing the angels were frightened and fell down like dead body. While the women were watching all these things, the angel talked to them "don't be frightened. I know that you are searching for the crucified Jesus. He is not here. Like He said earlier, He is resurrected. Come and see where he was kept". The angel also told them to go and tell the disciples that Jesus is resurrected from the dead. The women left the tomb with fear and joy and rushed to the disciple. But the resurrected Jesus appeared before them. He blessed them. The women wished Jesus. He said to them to go to Galilee and inform the disciples all these things. He also told them that He will appear to the disciples before they reach there.

Conclusion: Our Jesus is the God who died but resurrected. While all the tombs of those lived in this world and dead are lying closed, the tomb of Jesus is lying opened today.


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

Conclusion: Dear friends, Jesus will come back for taking us to Him. Let us wait and be ready for Him.






