CHAPTER NO & NAME	MV REFERENCES	VERSES
20. FUNDAMENTAL DOCTRINES OF THE CHURCH	Colossians 1:28	Him we preach, warning every man and teaching every man in all wisdom, that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus.
21. REPENTENCE	Acts 2:38	Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.
22. BAPTISM	Mark 16: 16	He who believes and is baptized will be saved; but he who does not believe will be condemned.
23. GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT	1 Corinthians 12: 13	For by one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—whether Jews or Greeks, whether slaves or free—and have all been made to drink into one Spirit.
24. GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (contd)	Isaiah 28: 10, 11	For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept, line upon line, line upon line, here a little, there a little." For with stammering lips and another tongue He will speak to this people.
25. SEPARATION	Malachi 3: 18	Then you shall again discern Between the righteous and the wicked, Between one who serves God And one who does not serve Him.
26. THE APOSTOLIC DOCTRINES & FELLOWSHIP	Acts 2: 32, 33	This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses. Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear.
27. PRAYER	John 9: 31	Now we know that God does not hear sinners; but if anyone is a worshiper of God and does His will, He hears him.
28. THE LORD'S TABLE	1 Corinthians 11: 26	For as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes.
29. MISSION OF THE CHURCH	Luke 24: 46, 47	Then He said to them, "Thus it is written, and thus it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead the third day, and that repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

30. MISSION OF THE CHURCH(contd)	Colossians 3: 16	Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
31. THE DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS	II Thessalonians 3: 6	But we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that you withdraw from every brother who walks disorderly and not according to the tradition which he received from us.
32. HOPE OF THE CHURCH	I Thessalonians 4: 16, 17	For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.
33. CHRISTIAN CHURCHES IN KERALA	II Corinthians 6: 16	And that agreement has the temple of God with idols? For you are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will dwell in them and walk among them. I will be their God, and they shall be My people."
34. THE JACOBITE-ORTHODOX CHURCHES	I Timothy 2: 5, 6	For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.
35. THE MARTHOMITE CHURCH	Philippians 3: 18, 19	For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the cross of Christ: whose end is destruction, whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame – who set their mind on earthly things.
