To the Teachers

- 1. <u>Aim:</u> when a lesson is taught, the teacher must make sure that the purpose of the lesson is impressed in the mind of the student. The teacher must be convinced of the purpose of the lesson which is mentioned in the beginning of each lesson and shall not deviate from the stem of thought.
- 2. <u>Preparing passages:</u> The teacher should read thoroughly the text, supporting scripture portions and other available materials in advance. The teacher shall arrange it to be explained within the given time. The teacher must well acquaint with the theme.
- 3. <u>Memory verse:</u> The memory verses of each lesson are given (NKJV) in the curriculum and the student is expected to memorise the same. <u>It is important to note that the given verses (according to the curriculum) should write in the examination.</u> The memory verse may be corelated to the lesson as well as the present life. It is important to say memory verse in each class before starting lessons.
- 4. Reading Passages: Bible reading is highly important in the life of a believer. Hence the student is expected to read all the passages related with each lesson and the teacher should make sure that the student has read all the biblical passages of the lesson, before starting a new lesson.
- 5. <u>Practical lesson:</u> Practical lesson is highly important. It is the duty of the teacher to communicate the practical lesson in a better manner.
- 6. <u>Methods:</u> Lectures, Group Discussions, Assignments/worksheets Assignments should be submitted by the end of September.
- 7. **Teaching Aid:** The teacher shall prepare necessary teaching aid materials for each lesson.
- 8. **Questions:** The questions of each chapter should be answered by the student and the student is expected to keep **a note book** which consists of notes, memory verses, questions, and answers.
- 9. Evaluation Process: Final examination (90%), Assignment (10%)
