## To the Teachers

- Practical lesson: Practical lesson is highly important. It is the duty of the teacher to communicate the practical lesson in a better manner.
- Teaching aid: The teacher shall prepare necessary teaching aid materials for each lesson.
- Questions: The questions of each chapter should be answered by the student and the student is expected to keep a note book which consists of notes, memory verses, questions, and answers.
