<p>9. THE PRIESTHOOD OF AARON</p>	<p>1 Peter 2: 9</p>	<p>But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;</p>
<p>10. THE PRIESTHOOD OF CHRIST</p>	<p>Hebrews 7: 26</p>	<p>For such a High Priest was fitting for us, who is holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and has become higher than the heavens;</p>
<p>11. THE SACRIFICES (OFFERINGS) OF ISRAELITES</p>	<p>Galatians 6: 14</p>	<p>But God forbid that I should boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.</p>
<p>12. THE SACRIFICES OF ISRAELITES (CONTD)</p>	<p>Hebrews 13: 15</p>	<p>Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name.</p>
<p>13. THE TABERNACLE</p>	<p>Exodus 25: 8</p>	<p>And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them.</p>
<p>14. THE MAIN PARTS OF THE TABERNACLE</p>	<p>Hebrews 10: 1</p>	<p>For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect.</p>
<p>15. THE FEASTS OF ALMIGHTY JEHOVAH</p>	<p>Psalms 118: 15</p>	<p>The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tents of the righteous; The right hand of the LORD does valiantly.</p>

<p>16. THE FEASTS OF ALMIGHTY JEHOVAH (CONTD.)</p>	<p>1 Corinthians 5: 7, 8</p>	<p>Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us. Therefore let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, nor with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.</p>

THE FEASTS OF ALMIGHTY JEHOVAH (CONTD.)</p>	<p>1 Thessalonians 4: 16, 17</p>	<p>For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first. Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.</p>
